

Wood River Wolf Project

Band Kit Agreement

2016 Field Season

As a producer collaborator (the “Operator”) in the Wood River Wolf Project (“WRWP” or the “Project”), you are entitled to receive, each season, subject to availability, a collection of nonlethal tools (a “Band Kit”) to be used for the purpose of maintaining separation between wolves (and other predators) and your livestock. Our hope is to equip each of your sheep bands that is scheduled to graze in the area protected by the Project (the “Protected Area”) for some portion of the grazing season with a Band Kit for the duration of their stay in the Protected Area.

Band Kits are comprised of high quality, currently available deterrent devices. In some cases, only one example of a deterrent may be included (for example, one starter pistol) and in other cases, multiple devices may be included (for example, Foxlights). Not all of the effective deterrents in the Project’s inventory are included in Band Kits (for example, several turbo-fladry kits are maintained by the Project for use in the field as needed, requested and practicable).

The majority of the equipment in each Band Kit will be assembled and delivered in a labelled duffel bag (permanently embroidered with the Kit’s number, such as: “WRWP Band Kit #[_]”). A per-band collection of T posts (for installing Foxlights) will be delivered in a separate labelled bag along with a stake pounder. Each Band Kit will include a sheet itemizing its contents.

The Project will be pleased to train your herders in the selection, implementation and rotation of these tools so that they (the herders and the tools) will be effective in the field and the risk of wolf habituation is minimized. We suggest that this training occur before your bands enter wolf country and the Protected Area.

WRWP staff carefully researched each piece of equipment to find the most effective and durable items at the best price. The aggregate MSRP for the equipment in each Band Kit is \$3,144.74, but the Project was able to procure the equipment for \$2,005.76.

Band Kits will be made available to producer collaborators *free of charge*. However, if any piece of equipment is (1) lost, stolen or misplaced, or (2) damaged beyond normal wear and tear, the *Operator will be responsible for reimbursing the Project at the discounted WRWP purchase price(s) for the affected item(s)*, as shown in the table below (the “Table 1”), which is made a part of this Agreement.

In this way, Band Kits will remain available for operator use during subsequent field seasons; each Band Kit checked out to an operator will be complete and the equipment serviceable when the Kit is checked out; operators will enjoy free use of Band Kits subject, however, to the cost of repair or replacement, if necessary, as stipulated above; and all parties will benefit from the Project's purchase economies.

The purpose of this Agreement is to ensure that all parties are aware of the requirements of the Band Kit program and the replacement cost of each constituent piece of equipment.

By signing this Agreement, Operator agrees to:

1. Ensure that the herder(s) using the equipment are trained by Operator's own employees who are well-versed in their use and/or by Project staff;
2. Not use the equipment in the Band Kit for purposes not related to protecting livestock from predators;
3. Not lend the equipment in the Band Kit to persons or entities not subject to this Agreement;
4. Not hold the Project liable for injury or death resulting from use of the equipment in the Band Kit; and
5. Return the Band Kit, including the duffel bags and all included equipment in reasonably good condition or, if not possible for whatever reason, to reimburse the WRWP at the "WRWP price" as listed in Table 1.
